

**Golf Course
Covid-19 Precautions and Procedures**

As of Monday 29th June, the golf course will now be open between the hours of 07:30 and 19:00. Tee times until 12:00 is dedicated for our members, however, visitors may play from this point onwards. We emphasise that if you would like to play YOU MUST BOOK ONLINE and in advance. If you cannot make a booked tee time please call or email to cancel so that other players will have the opportunity to play. If a player does not turn up for a booked tee time their membership account will still be charged.

The club still operates according to the government guidance to "PLAY SAFE, STAY SAFE" and the following rules will apply to all.

By choosing to play at Dudsbury you hereby accept the new rules in place which are designed to create a safe environment for both my staff and all golfers at Dudsbury.

In order to play golf safely the following rules apply:

- Please arrive at the course no more than 30 minutes before you are due to start, to ease congestion around the club and the nearby areas.
- You must adhere to government social distancing guidelines at all times (the 2 metre rule).
- You must not come to the club if you, or any member of your household, have any Coronavirus symptoms; you suspect you may have the virus or have been in contact with someone who has the virus.
- Changing room doors will be wedged open for use of the toilet facilities only. Changing rooms and showers are out of use. Please change into your golf shoes at your car.
- Golfers are advised not to arrive early or congregate in groups prior to their tee times or after their game.
- A takeaway service is available at the club at weekends, until the re-opening of the bar can commence on Saturday 4th July.
- If any of the rules are abused, club disciplinary procedures will come into force.
- When checking in for your tee time please abide by the 1 person rule in the Golf Reception at all times.
- Signage and guidance have been added to near the 1st tee and golf reception area for additional guidance.

The above list of rules is not exhaustive and we will continue to assess risk and follow updated Government advice. It may be necessary to add to or amend the list of guidelines, during this week, or indeed during the weeks and months to come.

As of Monday 29th June, the club gates will open at 07:15am each day and be locked when the last booked group leaves the course. Changing rooms and the golf reception will be closed at 19:00 each day.
